- Parents spoke about UCCS having more events/meetings where families could build relationships with one another.
- Parent briefly asked a question about field trips.
- Discussion on Black History Months. Ideas discussed include:
 - Assigning a figure for each class to research
 - Having students look back at family history to find an important figure whom students are related to
- Discussion about UCCS Attendance Policy & Procedures
 - UCCS Attendance Currently at ~83% (low compared to past attendance figures)
 - Lead to a discussion about helping families receive necessary services (food, clothing, transportation, etc) and how to get this information to UCCS families.

PAC Meeting #2-11/17/2022

- Parent and staff introductions
- Parents will know meeting dates in advance.
 - → Send out email (1 week prior)
 - → Phone call (day before each meeting)
- PAC meeting will be held every 3rd Thursday of the month from 5-6 pm.
- Parent/Teacher Conference Discussion
 - → Parents shared that teachers were very clear and detailed about their child's learning.
 - → Teachers explained the meaning and understanding of the newly standards based report cards for students.
 - → Teachers provided parents with suggestions that they could use at home to assist with student learning.
 - → Parents were very pleased to receive NYS test scores and iReady test data for their child.
 - → Parents were informed that test scores data is used to group students and guide instruction for student improvement.
- Discussed dismissal policy for picking up children
 - → Parents shared that they felt the pick-up process during dismissal takes too long and that they have to stand out in the cold while waiting.
 - → It was explained to parents that safety is UCCS' first priority to ensure that students are picked up by the authorized individual.
 - → The CEO shared that UCCS is looking into implementing a new online system for parent pick-ups that includes generating an instant message to parents.
- Parents asked about the closing of school this past Monday
 - → The CEO also shared that UCCS is working on improving and updating our school website as well as communication for families.
 - → A parent shared that she did not receive the robo call for the closing of school. However she did receive the email but did not check her email that morning.
 - → The CEO shared that school was canceled for Monday due to a high number of staff and teacher absences due to sickness.
- Need parent volunteer for the Board Of Trustees meeting every 2nd Thursday of the month.
- Parent suggestions and questions discussed
 - → Parents asked how is UCCS being proactive to prevent bullying?
 - → Mr. Samuel shared that UCCS has implemented Restorative Practices as part of the school culture.
 - → In addition, UCCS is actively looking for noticings of our students such as, facial expressions, body language, and being accessible to students.

- → Students also have the opportunity to receive daily check-ins from preferred staff members to share any concerns, thoughts and feelings.
- → One parent expressed that she feels that UCCS is doing a great job with keeping the children safe and engaged in learning.
