
Average Referrals Per Day Per Month 2022-23

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




Referrals By Location




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Referrals By Problem Behavior 12/1/22 - 12/30/22



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


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Referrals By Student 12/1/22 - 12/30/22



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
Referrals By Day Of Week 12/1/22 - 12/30/22


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Referrals By Grade 12/1/22 - 12/30/22
